MONEY NEEDED / MEALS:

Students will need money for meals while traveling on both travel days (breakfast, lunch, and dinner on Wednesday and lunch and dinner on Saturday). The hotel will provide breakfast each morning and we will provide lunches for the 3 days of competition (Thursday, Friday and Saturday). They may bring extra money for shopping, souvenirs, extra food/drinks, and snacks. We highly suggest that each student bring drinks and snacks for the trip (for the bus rides and for their hotel room) as the vending machines are very expensive. Get with your roommates to determine who will bring what.

DRESS CODE:

All team members are required to wear a clean team shirt each day of the event. They all should have 3 team shirts (the older tshirt, the 25th anniversary tshirt, and the new red polo). Only the red team pullover or the red flight jacket may be worn over the team shirt during competition. No other jackets or sweatshirts may be worn; however, undershirts are fine. No shorts! Only long jean pants, black pants, or khaki pants (without holes) are allowed as part of the uniform. For safety reasons, only closed-toe and closed-heel shoes may be worn to the competition. No flip-flops, sandals, or Crocs.

Each student is responsible for getting themselves up on time and being at the bus on time. We will coordinate wake-up calls with the hotel based on when we feel you should wake up.

Please make sure all students have a cell phone with them.

Any inappropriate behavior will terminate participation on the team and the student will be sent home at the expense of the parents.

Parents are welcome to attend this event. If parents/guardians wish to attend, they are responsible for making their own room reservations and for payment of their rooms and transportation. The competition is free to attend and is open to the public. If spectators wish to purchase one of our team t-shirts, you may do so for \$10.
